Sally's Angels is excited to announce the tremendous success of its first year as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, raising funds and sharing the resources of our community in celebration of Sally Rice to support families with critically and chronically ill children in need in our area's medical facilities.

Friends of Sally's Angels, every one of you an "angel" yourself, have supported the mission of Sally's Angels (see box to the left) with your overwhelmingly generous gifts.

Thanks to your support, Sally's Angels has begun living out its mission in earnest with dozens of gifts granted in 2006, beginning in September soon after the first annual Sally's Angels Afternoon Tea.

2006's Tea brought nearly **\$25,000** in gifts from all of Sally's Angels. WOW!

In just the last quarter of 2006, Sally's Angels supported families' needs as identified and referred to us by area social workers and other professionals with a total of almost **\$5,000**, paid to **31** families in amounts of \$250 or less, according to our established bylaws.
